Directions for Use

Feed at a rate of 10-12 pounds per head per day or may be self-fed, depending on forage quality and stage of production. Monitor feed levels in self-feeders so that an adequate amount of feed is always available. Running out of feed can lead to overeating when self-feeders are refilled.

Unlimited roughage in the form of hay or pasture should be provided. Fresh, clean water should be available at all times.

Do not feed to sheep due to high copper levels.
